Preliminary research on the internet showed the cost of a Qatar Airways flight leaving Johannesburg on Wednesday 29 Feb 2012 and returning from Melbourne on Wednesday 14 March 2012 as R9530.00 - all taxes included. This entails a journey time of about 23 hours and a stop over in Doha both ways.
